In Respect of Special Service Proposal No. 01-2011 Ward 4 Drainage Maintenance Program

The council of The Rural Municipality of Grey intends to give third reading to By-Law 12-2011 to approve the following Special Service Proposal.

The Rural Municipality of Grey plans to establish a special service levy for a Drainage Maintenance Program for all properties with Class 30 (farm) land assessment in the area known as Ward 4 in the Rural Municipality of Grey. All monies collected under this proposed special service will be put towards drain maintenance and improvements which will be beneficial to Ward 4 property owners. There are approximately 125 miles of work to be done. Works will include surveying, licensing, clean outs to ditch bottom, clean out of vegetation, mowing, etc. All works will be contracted out. This special service will apply for the years 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015, 2016 and 2017. Please see attached Special Service Proposal for further details.

Potential taxpayers under this Special Service Proposal by-law may object to the by-law by filing a notice of objection with the Secretary to the Municipal Board, 1144-363 Broadway, Winnipeg, Manitoba, R3C 3N9, within 30 days of the date of this notice.

A notice of objection must contain the name and address of the person filing the objection, identify the by-law number, identify the property in respect of which the objection is filed and state the grounds to the objection.
